Each provides a broad overview of sociological contributions, both theoretical and substantive, to understanding key aspects of contemporary society and may be used as preliminary reading for the topics covered by the lectures. For students new to sociology, Giddens and Haralambos include particularly useful overviews of the sociological perspective and the theoretical and methodological debates that have developed within the discipline. Throughout the course, it is useful to keep in mind some of the different approaches to sociology that have been developed. These include structural, cultural, historical and comparative and rational choice. The more specific readings which follow are - for essay convenience - grouped by substantive topic, though the lectures are structured by analytic strategy.
